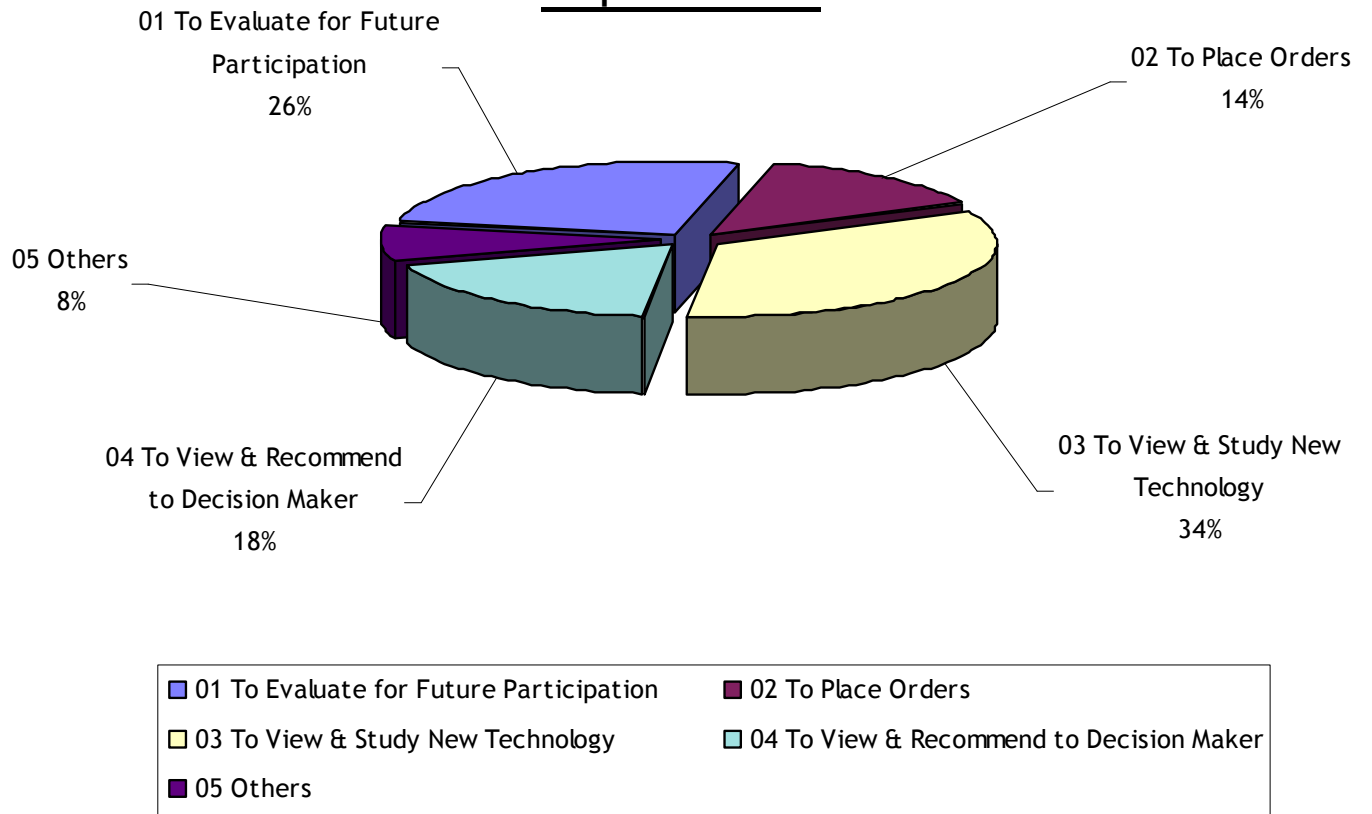
Visitors by Main Industry
